

EXHIBIT A

SCOPE OF SERVICES

ST. JOSEPH'S SCHOOL

The Lennox School District (hereinafter, the "District") seeks to engage St. Joseph's School to offer in-person support services for students enrolled in the Lennox Virtual Academy (hereinafter, "LVA"), the District's full-time independent study program. For a period of at least two (2) hours of each designated school day, LVA Lab/Groups Sessions shall be held at St. Joseph's School to provide students with in-person support for completing assigned independent study coursework, as well as enrichment opportunities. St. Joseph's School shall provide the District with the following support services in connection with LVA Lab/Group Sessions:

- Access and use of all K-8 classrooms;
- One-on-one or small group support/enrichment/tutoring services from all K-8 teachers, including K-8 substitute teachers; and
- Access and use of all K-8 infrastructures, including furniture, utilities, computers, and internet connectivity.

The LVA Lab/Group Session services described above shall be subject to the following conditions:

- All Lab/Group Sessions shall be administered by the District;
- The District's LVA teachers of record shall be solely responsible for the development and implementation of the independent study curriculum;
- St. Joseph's School teachers and staff shall serve only as facilitators and shall receive all direction from the LVA teachers of record;
- The District's LVA teachers of record shall determine the exact nature of the teacher support services St. Joseph's teachers and staff shall provide to students during LVA Lab/Group Sessions; and
- There shall be no religious instruction during the performance of any LVA Lab/Group Sessions services.
